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1.1.1. Ethical and Social Issues

- Avoid spying, snooping or eavesdropping
- Avoid excessive demands, e.g. right with correct balance
- Applying only a few **principles** can be too restrictive
- Apply the **four basic ethical principles** to avoid legal problems, but also a high professional standard:
 - "The only proper function of the government is just that of the state itself: protect the liberty for each individual"
 - Be wary of the **three limitations** of the **four basic ethical principles** as suggested by
 - Apply the **four basic ethical principles** (autonomy, beneficence, non-maleficence, justice)
 - Apply the **four basic ethical principles** with **subprinciples**:
 - **Autonomy**: freedom of choice, no **coercion**, **deception**, **undue influence**, **informed consent**, **voluntary**, **competent**
 - **Beneficence**: **do good**, **act in the best interests**, **apply the principle**, **act in the best interests**
 - **Non-maleficence**: **do no harm**, **act in the best interests**, **apply the principle**, **act in the best interests**
 - **Justice**: **fairness**, **equity**, **act in the best interests**, **apply the principle**, **act in the best interests**
- It is possible to have the **four basic ethical principles** and **three limitations** at the same time
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
